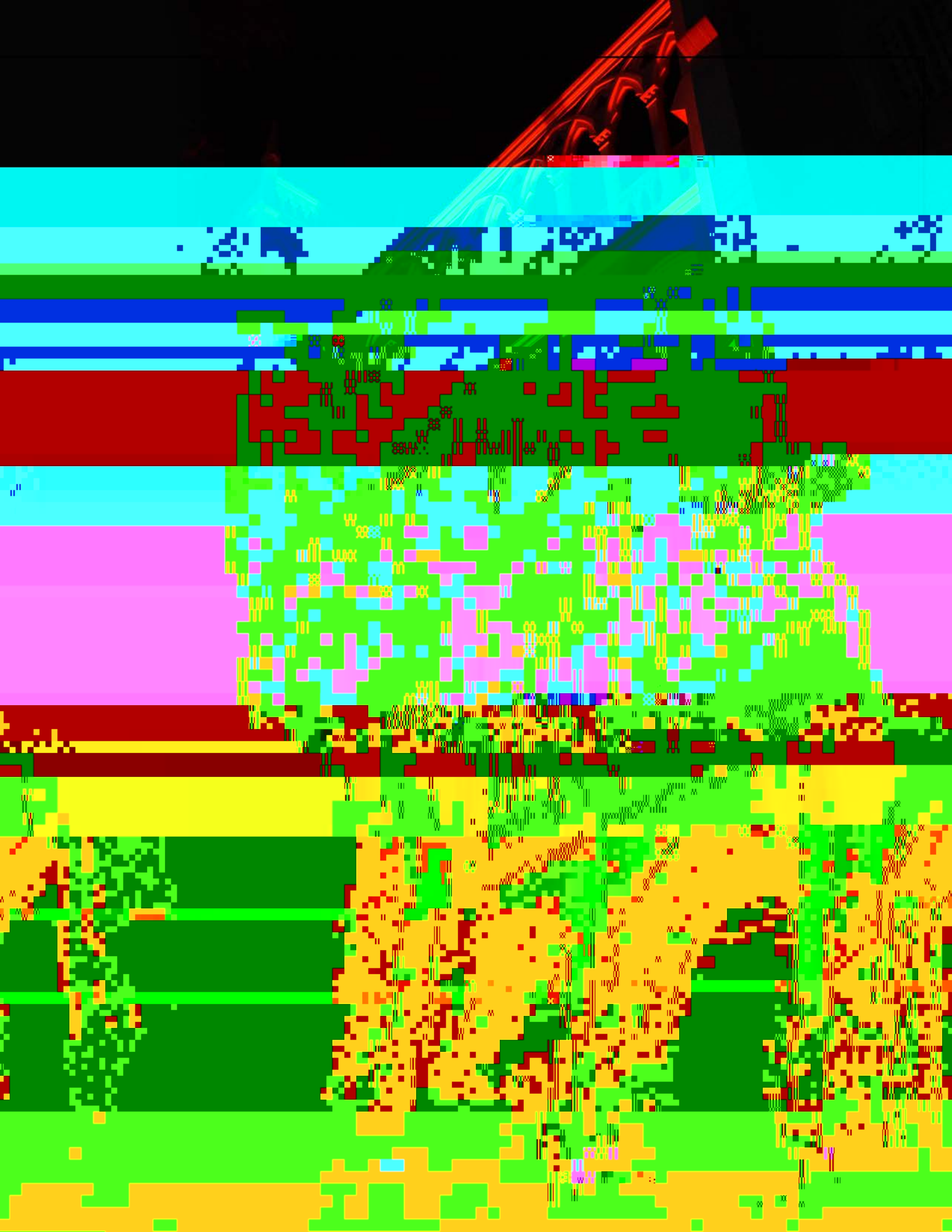

MOM For Moms

A follow – up visit in Bauko was conducted last September 27, 2019 to monitor the implementation of the Mobile Obstetrics Monitoring Project that was launched last January 17, 2019. The visit was attended by CEC staff headed by its Director, Prof. Joselito J. Tablang, with 2 social workers and 2 doctors of the College of Medicine- Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology.


From January to present, a total of 283 pregnant women in Bauko were checked using the lumify - a portable ultrasound attached to a cellular phone or tablet that was lent by the project to Bauko.

During the visit, a SWOT analysis was conducted. Some of the major positive points of the project include the eagerness of the pregnant mothers to visit rural health clinic,



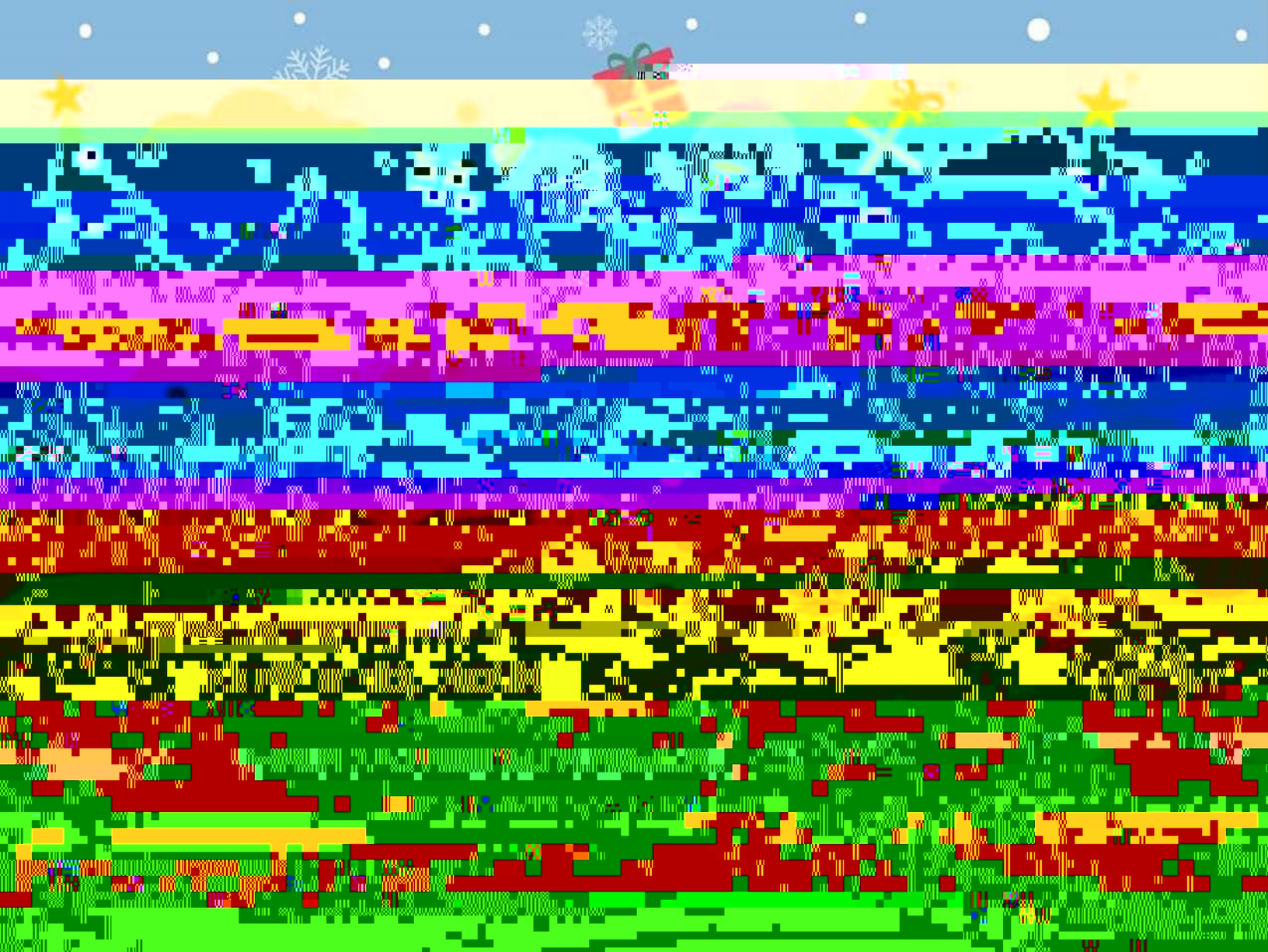
the early referral of high-risk patients and Rural Health Unit was able to fulfil their prenatal services. Follow up trainings were given by our OB doctors Dr. Jose Augusto Genio and Dr. Rex Poblete to 24 health workers of RHU Bauko on Pre- Natal Care and Basic Obstetrics Ultrasonography.
